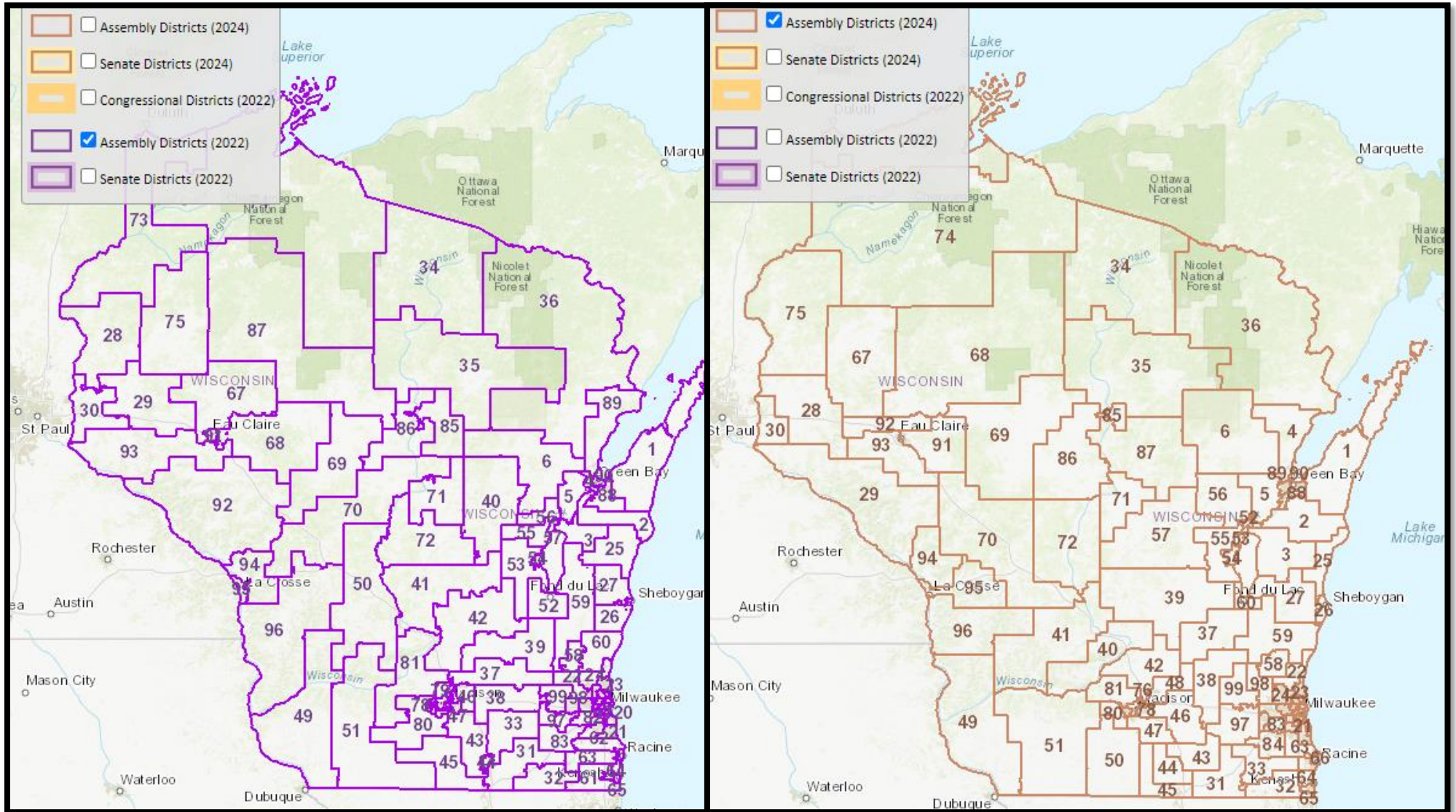

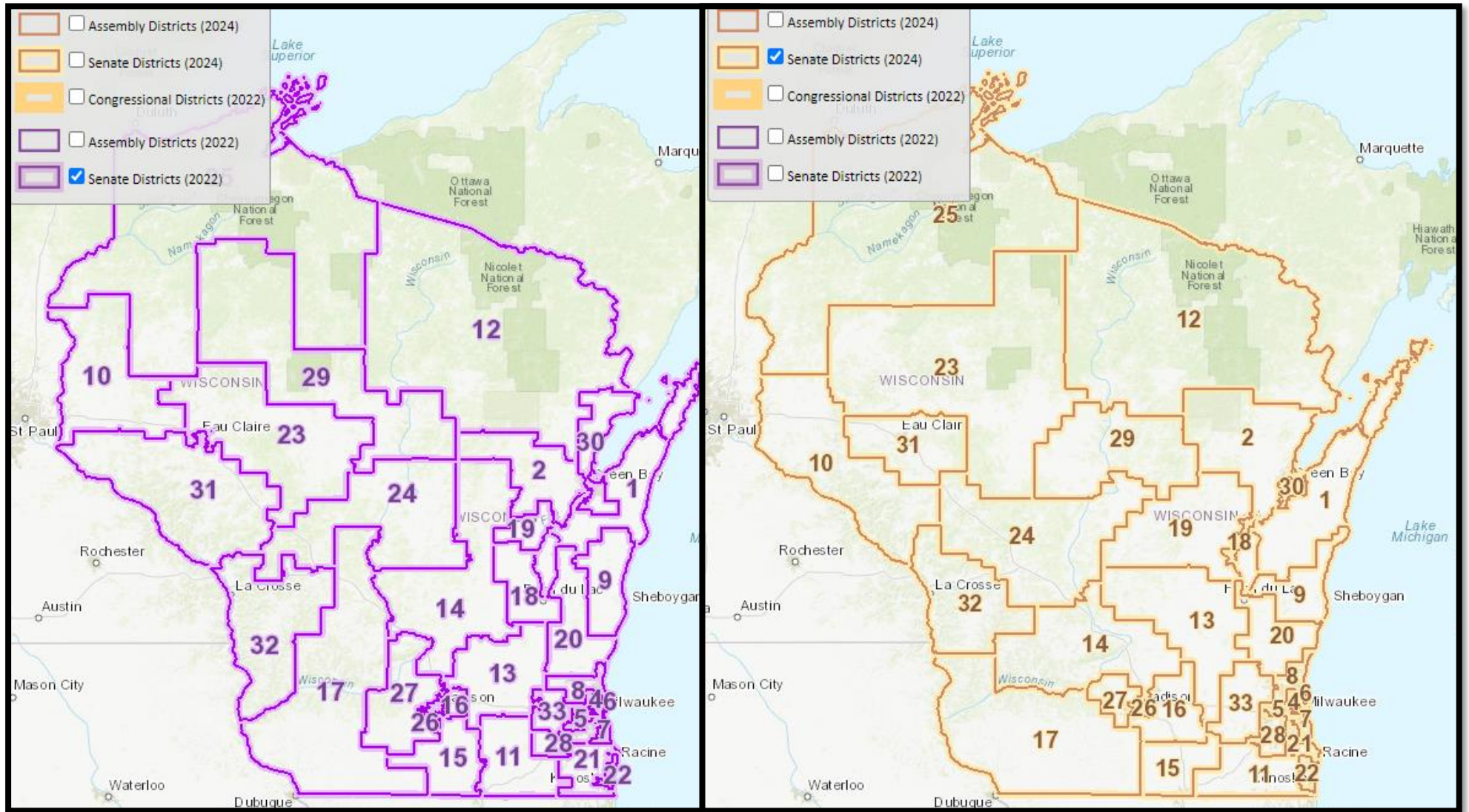
Note that US District 3 Representative Van Orden and US Senators Baldwin and Johnson remain unchanged.

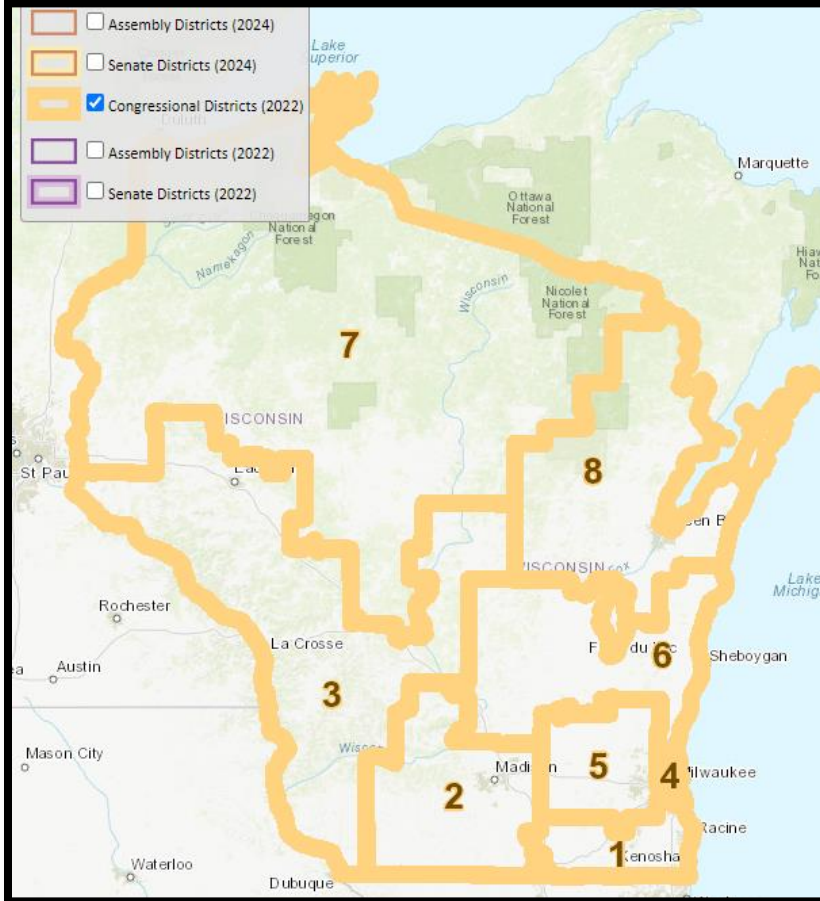
Current New Hope WISCONSIN Assembly Districts 2022-2024 (left) and the NEW DISTRICT Borders Effective November 2024

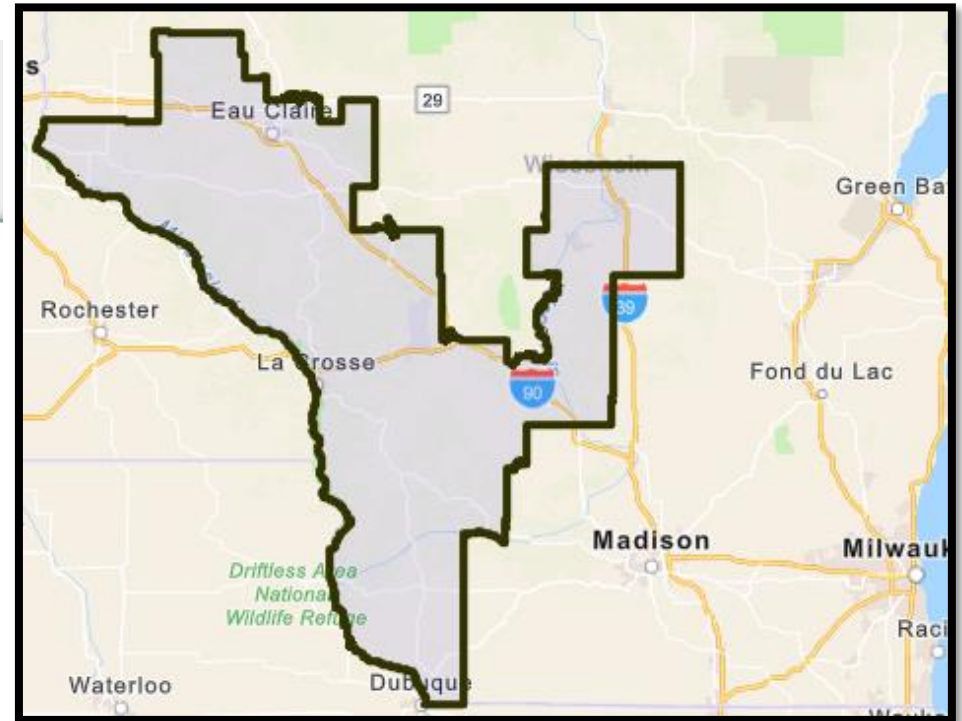
